COVID UPDATE

Compass Christian Preschool continues to seek guidance from Tarrant County Health Department and Texas State Childcare Licensing. They have started making some changes regarding the length of quarantine after an exposure. We will continue to follow our Health and Illness policy. If your child exhibits any of the symptoms outlined in our Screening Procedures (or any other illness symptoms) while at preschool, they will be immediately isolated from other children and you will be called to take them home. Your child must be picked up within 30 minutes of the phone call and must remain home for 48 hours regardless of circumstance. Please note that the health department will not let us attempt to distinguish whether the symptoms are caused by COVID-19 or another cause such...CONTINUED PG 2

COVID UPDATE CONT...

...as allergies or a common cold. Any one of these symptoms prevents a child from attending preschool until they have been symptom free for 48 hours.

If Compass Christian Preschool must close because of the COVID-19 virus after the first of the month, tuition will not be refunded or prorated. If this closure extends into the following month, then tuition will be prorated for that month.

If a classroom(s) must be quarantined, tuition will not be prorated or refunded as we will pay our teachers during this time.
